The AYHC is a safe and supportive place for youth ages 12-24 to get health and social care from a trustworthy and caring team of doctors, nurses and social workers.

Services offered:

- Medical care
- Harm reduction supplies + support
- Justice navigation
- Mental health supports (ages 16+)
- Sexual health supports (STI testing and treatment, pregnancy testing/options, and contraception options)
- Pharmacy services
- Basic needs support + case management
- Variety of groups (closed and open)
- LGBTQ2S+ supports
- Prenatal and parenting programs
- ID document support
- Counseling

What Youth Have To Do

Contact Judy McCuaig to schedule a time to visit The Alex Youth Health Centre.

When youth go for a scheduled visit, one of the friendly staff will give them a tour and inform them of the the different services they offer and the different activities and programs youth can participate in.

Ask the youth to:

1. Get a business card or pamphlet so they can prove they visited.
2. Complete the Community Connection Reflection Sheet.

The youth should send or bring the completed Reflection Sheet plus the business card or pamphlet to final meeting.
