### What Youth Have To Do

No appointment is necessary, but registration is required for a first visit. Youth may be asked for their Social Insurance Number (SIN) at initial registration meeting.

- 2. Complete the Community Connection Reflection Sheet.

The youth should send or bring the completed Reflection Sheet plus the business card or pamphlet to final meeting.
